As We Gather: The Lord is faithful. His steadfast love never ceases, and *“his mercies never come to an end”* (Lam. 3:22–23). To keep us in repentance and to make our faith grow, He causes grief for a while, but He does not cast off forever; in due time, *“he will have compassion”* (Lam. 3:31–33). Therefore, *“hope in him,”* and *“wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD,”* for *“the LORD is good to those who wait for him”* (Lam. 3:24–26). That is what the woman did who had *“a discharge of blood,”* and also the ruler whose daughter was *“at the point of death.”* Each waited on the mercy of the Lord Jesus, and each received His saving help (Mark 5:21–28). The woman had suffered much for 12 years, and the ruler’s daughter had already died before Jesus arrived. Yet at the right time, the woman was immediately *“healed of her disease,”* and the little girl *“got up and began walking”* (Mark 5:29, 42). Such is *“the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ,”* who humbled Himself unto the extreme poverty of death *“so that you by his poverty might become rich,”* even unto life everlasting (2 Cor. 8:9).
